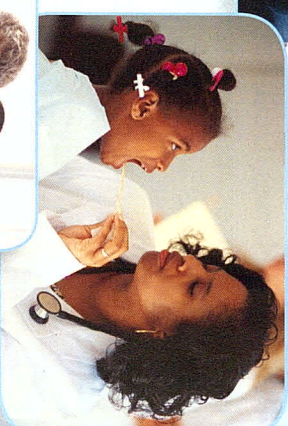

How does PCMH
Benefit the Patient?

- Each patient has their own Primary Care Provider (PCP).
- The PCP will take responsibility for arranging care with other qualified healthcare providers, if needed, for the patient.
- PCPs assure patients get the care they need when and where they need it.
- PCPs provide the patient with evidenced based care and support and encouragement with self-management.
- By having a PCP, all your medical records will be in one place.
- Accommodate same day appointments with PCP whenever possible.
- Personalized health care will meet patient needs.
- If you have any questions about your medication or health, you can call or email your PCP.

Responsibilities of Patient

- Sign Up with MediSys Mychart to communicate with your PCP through a secured email system.
- Let your PCP know of your past and ongoing health care conditions
- Let us know when you see other providers and what medications they put you on or change (i.e. specialists, emergency room visits, hospitalization).
